The The Salvation Army Houston Northwest Corps regularly provides meals, refreshments, and hospitality as part of our ongoing church programming and outreach efforts. Sharing food has become an important ministry tool that creates welcoming spaces for fellowship, relationship-building, and meaningful connection. From Corps gatherings and outreach events to Sunday school classes, youth programs, and special activities, providing meals and refreshments helps remove barriers, encourages participation, and creates opportunities for spiritual engagement alongside physical care.
